

Professor Paul McGreal is Director of the Corporate Compliance Center and the Harry and Helen Hutchens Research Professor at the South Texas College of Law in Houston, where he teaches professional responsibility, antitrust, and a seminar on corporate legal compliance. He is also on the faculty of the Executive MBA Program of the Mays Business School at Texas A&M University, where he teaches modules on business ethics, social responsibility, corporate compliance, and corporate governance.

Before joining the South Texas faculty, Professor McGreal was associated with Baker Botts L.L.P., where he practiced general civil litigation. Professor McGreal received his J.D. from SMU Law School and his LL.M. from Yale Law School

Professor McGreal has authored numerous publications, including over twenty articles and essays as well as a student textbook. Since Spring 2004, he has served as Director of the Corporate Compliance Center at the South Texas College of Law, where he organizes conferences and conducts compliance related research, including the Center's 2005 Best Practices Project.
