



**James D. Berg**

James Berg was raised in Louisville, Kentucky, received an undergraduate degree from Northwestern University, and a Masters in Public Administration with a concentration in international economics from Princeton University on a Woodrow Wilson fellowship.

Berg joined International Paper Company in 1993 as Executive Assistant to the Chairman and CEO. In 1994, Berg was appointed Director of Finance (CFO) for International Paper Europe. In 1998, he assumed the position of Director, Ethics and Business Practice. He has since assumed additional responsibilities in the areas of crisis management and corporate social responsibility.

In 1989, Berg was appointed by President Bush and confirmed by the US Senate as Executive Vice President of the Overseas Private Investment Corporation (OPIC), a US Government-owned corporation that provides political risk insurance and project financing to American companies investing in developing countries. Berg later served as President and CEO of OPIC.

Prior to 1989, Berg held positions in the United States Department of the Interior, the National Security Council, and the Department of State. This service followed two years in the United States Peace Corps.

Berg was elected to the Board of Directors of the Ethics and Compliance Officer Association in 2001 and re-elected in 2004. He was elected Vice-Chairman of the Board in 2006 and elected Chairman of the Board in 2008. He is a past Chairman and Executive Committee Member of the Conference Board's Global Council on Business Conduct. He has published articles on business ethics in Ethikos and Unity Magazine and is a frequent panelist on the topic. He has lectured in international relations and business ethics at Georgetown University, Johns Hopkins University's School of Advanced International Studies, the Kellogg Business School at Northwestern, Miami University of Ohio, Northern Illinois University (MBA programs) and Bentley College (Managing Ethics in Organizations).
